

St Thomas More Parish Ministries

As in a family, we in St Thomas More Parish should all be keen to share our gifts in maintaining a vibrant and inclusive parish family. A thriving parish is one in which each person/ family participates in at least one ministry.

We encourage you to volunteer to help with one or more ministries in our parish. **Consider committing to a ministry as a family.** Below is an overview of some of the ministries within the parish you may like to consider. We encourage and invite everyone to commit - there is something for everyone. We thank those who have volunteered in the past and urge you to recommit for another year in the same, or a different ministry. Familiarisation and training will be provided by parish coordinators, as required. **Note: POC = Point of Contact**

Welcomers / Ushers

Greeting people, assisting with COVID registration/restrictions, handing out bulletins. (POC: Parish Office)

Acolytes / Altar Servers

Assists Priest at the altar. Children are invited to be part of this ministry. They are given formation and practice. Their participation is an important contribution to the celebration and helps them gain a greater understanding and appreciation of the Mass. (POC: Fr Anthony & Parish Office)

Readers / Lectors

The Reader/ Lector proclaims the First and Second Readings, and the Responsorial Psalm (if there is no cantor). The Prayer of the Faithful is prayed by the Reader. (POC: Parish Office)

Musicians/ Vocalists

Musicians -- organists, guitarists, instruments and singers -- are encouraged to commit to this ministry, so that music can be shared at Mass. (POC: Parish Office)

Morning Tea

Serve morning tea, coffee and biscuits, after Mass. Parish can provide coffee/tea, serving materials and biscuits. (POC: Parish Office)

Children's Liturgy / Sacramental Preparation

Teach children about the readings during first half of Mass (during school terms only). Assist the Sacramental Coordinator with the delivery of the sacramental program to children not attending St Thomas More Primary School preparing to receive First Reconciliation, Holy Communion and Confirmation after Mass during the preparation period. (POC: Chris Evans/ STM teacher)

Liturgy Group

Assist with preparation for Mass, linen maintenance, brass cleaning, church flowers, maintain church cleanliness, decorating church at the change of liturgical seasons. (POC: Parish Office)

IT/Social Media/Branding

Develop and maintain the parish website and social media to ensure effective outreach and appropriate branding of the Parish to the public. Other roles include photography, tech support, audio/visual setup, communications, and maintain church signboard. (POC: Shannon Evans & Parish Office)

Outreach & Care

Home, hospital visitation, communion to the sick and housebound. (POC: Kym Duggan)

Groundskeeping

Maintain external appearance of church grounds through periodic cleaning details, occasional gardening (not lawn maintenance), and signboard currency. (POC: Parish Office)

Adult Faith Formation / St Thomas More Forum

Facilitate the forming and deepening of the Catholic faith in adult members of our community through religious education and faith-building events. Assist with the planning and presentation of the regular STM Forum events, including the dinner. (POC: Bill Mason)

Youth Ministry/Faith Formation

Facilitate the forming and deepening of the Catholic faith in youth and young adult members of our community through religious education and faith-building events such as Alphas, Youth Programs, and Apostolate. (POC: Zane Mason)

Parish Safe-Guarding Officers / Volunteers

The safety and wellbeing of Children is of utmost importance. As the parish Safe-Guarding Officer/Volunteer help ensure Our Parish remains a safe place for our children to grow in faith. (POC: Shannon Evans & Parish Office)
